Sorting livestock after the chute is safer than manually separating them in a holding pen. Post-Chute Cattle Drafting enables ranchers of any skill level to easily sort cattle after the chute using the flow established by running cattle through an open system.

BASED ON BASIC PRINCIPLES OF CATTLE BEHAVIOR

Cattle can only process one main thought at a time.

- Less distractions in a cattle handling system than in an open pen

Cattle want to remove pressure.

- Cattle are focused on escaping when placed in a handling system
